IMPLEMENTATION AND INSTALLATION OF THE ELECTRONIC GATE

After years of discussion, research, and planning, electronic security gates have finally been installed at Common Areas I and II. The new gates will not only increase ease of access in and out of the Common Areas but will aide in the misuse of the areas by non members. Members of the Cuckoo's Nest Association Board of Directors appreciate everyone's cooperation and patience as this new process gets under way. LOCK COMBINATION IN CASE OF GATE FAILURE

In the case of an <u>extended</u> power failure to the gate, the gate will be secured with a combination lock. That combination lock code will be 1289. This combination will not be changed year-to-year since this type of lock will only be used in extenuating circumstances.

COMMON AREA PARKING

As a community we can all help to maintain the integrity and usefulness of our common areas by remembering to park vehicles in the designated parking areas.

In Common Area II, only golf carts and utility vehicles are permitted to drive on the grass areas and park near the new covered docks. All other vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area. Please refrain from driving cars and trucks on the grassy area. These larger vehicles can damage the grass and soil. Your cooperation in adhering to the posted signs is greatly appreciated by all who use and maintain these areas.

COVERED BOAT SLIPS

The covered boat slips recently added at Common Area II are owned by Lake Anna Land Corporation, the Developer of Cuckoo's Nest. If you are interested in storing your boat in one of these slips, please contact LALC at 540-894-5100.

COMMON AREAS 1 AND 2 DOCK REPLACEMENT INFORMATION

For the past several months the CNA Board has been reviewing whether to repair the damaged dock in Common Area 1 or move forward with the Reserve Study advisement that docks 1 and 2 in Common Area 1 be replaced in 2020. After reviewing options the BOD voted to begin the replacement of the docks instead of paying to repair now then pay again to replace in just a few months. As docks are replaced lot owners/residents are advised that any enhancements that have been added at these docks (i.e., lifts, solar cells, etc.), by a lot owner/resident, are the responsibility of the lot owner/resident. Cuckoo's Nest Association is responsible for the docks only. As these docks need to be replaced, it is the lot owner's/resident's responsibility to have any lift or other enhancement removed prior to the demolition of the old dock. If the enhancement is to be reinstalled, the reinstallation is the responsibility of the lot owner/resident. Residents will be notified, as soon as possible, in advance of the beginning of the project, to make arrangements to have any enhancements removed. Any enhancement not removed before the beginning of the project will be removed by the contractor and that cost will be billed to the lot owner/resident.

Also, all boats housed within slips of a dock being replaced will need to be relocated before the dock replacement project begins.

The Board realizes there is some inconvenience to lot owners/residents regarding this type of project but know that the safety and reliability of these docks is of utmost concern to everyone involved. Your cooperation and patience is appreciated as the first phase of this project is being reviewed and will hopefully begin sometime December 2019 to January 2020.

Information regarding dock replacement construction dates will be on the Cuckoo's Nest Association website.
